## "How to: disable the User Account Control (UAC) in Windows 7"

To disable the User Account Control on Windows 7, follow the instructions below.

- 1. Open the "Control panel" and select the "User Accounts" option.
- 2. Enter the page that manages you account.
- 3. Click the "Change User Account Control" option.
- 4. Move the slider to the bottom (like in the picture below) to the "never notify" position.
- 5. Click OK and restart Windows.
